

### Field Trips

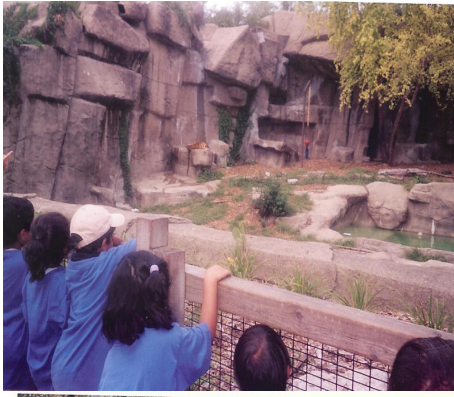


- All summer field trips are educational and appropriate to the age level.
